



### Onshore Electrician

The main purpose of the Electrician is to carry out inspection, maintenance and repairs on all of the Company's onshore plant, equipment and workshop buildings under the direction of the Electrical Chargehand.

You will be based in our workshops and duties will include:

- Carrying out the installation of new equipment in-house, ie, computer terminals, training school complex, lighting etc.
- Completing onshore crane boom rewire to include lighting, overhoist systems and safe load indicators.
- Carrying out re-certification inspections of power packs, flushing skids, etc.
- Carrying out P.A.T testing and maintaining the P.A.T. Register.
- Maintaining working stock of all lighting equipment.
- Ensuring that all work carried out for Clients has a Job Card raised.
