



Offshore Electrician

You will have completed a recognised Electrical Apprenticeship within an Engineering background. Previous offshore experience and knowledge of hazardous area equipment required. You should also have the ability to read electrical drawings.

You should have a proven track record in working with various makes of onshore/offshore cranes and be familiar with the crane industry's working standards and procedures.

Duties will include:

- Installation, maintenance and fault finding on a range of industrial equipment
- Completing onshore and offshore crane boom rewiring to include lighting, overhoist systems and safe load indicators.
- Completing crane service routines and advising and recommending repairs to be carried out.
- Preparing reports for Engineers
